

### Travel Information



#### By road:

From the South West, M5 leave at Junction 3 and join A456. Continue towards Birmingham on A456 until you reach FiveWays Island. No. 1, Hagley Road is on your left, immediately before the island.

From the M6, leave at Junction 6 (Spaghetti Junction). Join A38(M) to City Centre. Stay in the second lane of A38(M). Join and stay on A38 passing over the Aston University fly-over (Lancaster Circus) then the road bends right and left into the first of three tunnels (St Chad's Circus Queensway tunnel). Stay on A38 through a second and third tunnel. As you exit the third tunnel, stay in the extreme right hand lane. You are approaching the junction with the A4540 (Lee Bank Middleway) where you will be turning right, signposted M5. Pass Ford Bristol Street Motors on your left and at the junction you will see McDonalds opposite you on the right. Near the junction the right hand lane splits into a further feeder lane. As you turn right onto A4540 take care to turn into correct carriageway. Continue along A4540 (Lee Bank Middleway) staying in the left hand lane until you pass FiveWays railway station on your left. Ahead of you is FiveWays Island. You will also see No. 1, Hagley Road directly in front of you on the far side of the roundabout.



#### By rail:

At New Street station, board a train going to Longridge or Redditch. Get off at FiveWays (one stop). When leaving FiveWays station, turn left and keep walking straight ahead (it takes approximately 7 minutes to reach the building). You will see Number 1, Hagley Road in front of you on the far side as you reach the roundabout. Take the pedestrian underpass across the roundabout and as you exit the underpass you will see the entrance to the building in front of you.

Taxis are also available at New Street station. The journey to No. 1, Hagley Road is approximately 10 minutes.



#### Parking:

There are no car parking facilities at the Hagley Road building. Public parking facilities include the FiveWays Shopping Centre on Broad Street, Edgbaston Shopping Centre on Hagley Road, or the newly opened high secure Broadway Plaza Ladywood Middleway.

Please note: You may use the Tesco car park but be warned, free parking is only for three hours. If you use the car park for longer than this you are likely to receive a parking ticket.
